Dear friend,

What I have come to learn after covering wars across the Middle East is that breast cancer does not know any boundaries. I have recently learned that the incidence of breast cancer in Lebanon has risen to an alarming rate. You can help because this is a war in the Middle East that no one talks about and it is a war that we must win.

I am Jennifer Griffin. I cover National Security as the Fox News Pentagon correspondent. My husband Greg and I spent more than a decade reporting from the Middle East. I was diagnosed with Stage 3 Triple Negative breast cancer 6 years ago when our son was 6 months old. I spent the next 6 months throwing off the cancer that had taken over my body. Our two daughters were so young at the time, but they helped me get through the tough 17 rounds of chemotherapy, the double mastectomy and the weeks of radiation.

Last November, I had the privilege of being the Master of Ceremonies at the annual gala of the American Foundation for Saint George Hospital in Washington, DC. The Foundation is committed to fight breast cancer in Lebanon and has dedicated proceeds from the gala to establish a free comprehensive program to transport needy women from remote communities in Lebanon to be screened at Saint George Hospital in Beirut, one of the three largest hospitals in Lebanon.
